Professor Teng Su Ching was awarded an Honorary Professorship at the Singapore University of Social Sciences, where she spent more than 15 years, during which time she set up the Centre for Continuing and Professional Education. She was also instrumental in setting up the Centre for Social Good. She is attached to the Nathan School of Human Development where she is helping to set up a Programme on Community Care. This programme will formalise the practice of care and prepare students and volunteers for the future of work in the care economy. Prior to her appointment at the Singapore University of Social Sciences, she was the Vice-Dean (Special Project and Outreach) of the LKY School of Public Policy.

Professor Teng is the President of the Loving Heart Multi-Service Centre which runs an SGCares Volunteer Centre and three Active Ageing Centres. She was on the Boards of the Singapore Children's Society, Singapore AfterCare Association. She served in the Public Transport Council and many community organisations. She was appointed Justice of the Peace in 2006 and was awarded the Public Service Star, or Bintang Bakti Masyarakat (BBM), in 2017.
